Restrictions

We reserve the right to refuse participation to anyone who contravenes these guidelines. A refund may not be given in such circumstances. It is the organisers' responsibility to inform members of their group of these restrictions.

A parental consent form must be completed for anyone under the age of 18 and any participant under 18 must be fully accompanied by a parent or guardian

Participants will be asked to sign a risk acceptance form on arrival highlighting medical conditions. Things that may pose a problem are: Pregnancy, Skeletal and Muscular Problems, Heart and Respiratory Problems, Recent Operations. If any of these affect you please phone for advice – Asthma and diabetes do not normally restrict participation. Please bring any medication you require.

Please note – Paddlecrest Coaching reserves the right to refuse participation to clients they believe to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs and in such circumstances no refunds shall be given

Finally, please note that minimum numbers are required to run trips. If this number is not achieved 3 days before the trip is due to go-ahead, we will contact you to make suitable alternative arrangements.
